The other letter may be from another non-family member, such as a representative of your school, a former coach, or a member of an organization where you have had community involvement.

Personal Essay:

The essay must be a minimum of one page and of unlimited length, double-spaced, typewritten or printed clearly on 8 ½ x 11 sheets of paper. This essay will count for half of the weight for this scholarship. It should include interpersonal relationships, service to the community and personal values and achievements. Whenever possible it should relate to how your involvement with the Chili Lions Football and Cheerleading Program influenced those achievements.
